

Edhelfridus Bernicoru.	of 2200, whiche came to praye for the god successe of the Britaynes, and by hys wife Accan, the daughter of Elle, had viii. sonnes, Eadfridus, Osualdus, Osvius, Oslacius, Osmundus, Ofa, Offa. Flor. Histor.
Edwinus, Northumber- land, slaine.	Thys Edwinus was the first of the Northumberland kings, whiche was converted and Christened by Paulinus Bishop of London.
Oriscus Deiorum, slaine.	These two are put out of the race of kings, because they revolted fro the Christian faith, and were both slayne miserably by Cedwalla a Britayne, which then raigned in Northumberland, and in Mercia.
Oswaldus, Northumber- land, slaine.	This Oswaldus, called S. Oswald, fought with Cedwalla, & Penda with a small army, and by strenght of prayer vanquished the in the field. He sent for Edanus into Scotland to preach in hys country, & as he preached in Scotland, y king expounded in English. He was a great gener of armes to y prie. Of his other actes more appereath hereafter.
Osvius, Northumber- land.	This Osvius fighting against Penda, vowed to make his daughter Alfreda a Nonne, gowing wth her, ii. Lordships, to build ii. Monasteries. vi. in Bernicia, vi. in Deira.
Osvinus raigned to- gether with Osvius in Deira slaine.	The same Osvius in the beginning of hys raigne toke one Osvinus the sonne of Edwyne to be his partene ac- ter the countrey of Deira. Afterward causyngh him to be killed, toke to hym an other called Edelwald, the sonne of Oswalde. Of thys Osvynus more fol- loweth hereafter to be declared.
Egfridus, Northumber- land, slaine.	Thys Egfrid married Etheldrida, who being xi. yeares maried to hym, could after by no meanes be allure to lyve with him, but obtainyng of hym li- cence, was made Nunne, & then Ab- bes of Elye. She made but one meale a day, & neuer weare linnen. At last the same Egfrid fighting against y Scots, was slayne in the fielde by a trayne of the Scots, faining themselues to flee.
Alridus, Northumber- land, slaine.	Of this Alfrid, Bede in his historie testifieth that he was exacly and per- fectly seene in the holy Scriptures, & recovered much that hys predecessors had lost before. Bed.lib.4. cap.24. Some say he raigned not 18. yeares.
Osred, Northumber- land, slaine.	Osred began his raigne being but viii. years old, and raigned the space of x. yeares.
Kenredus, North. Oriscus, North.	Some affirme that Oriscus raign- ed but xi. yeares.
Celafus, Northumb. made Moyle.	This Celafus after he had raigned 8. years was made a Monke. To hym Egbertus, or Eadber- tus, Northumberlaid, Monke.
Mollo, or Ethelwold, North.	Mollo by the subtil traine of Altredus was made away, whiche Altredus also himselfe after he had raigned x. yeares, mad emisshen to his owne nesone.
Altredus, Northum- berland, ex- pulsed.	In some Chronicles in some Chronicles this Altredus raigned but viii. yeares.
Ethelbertus, or Edelredus, Northumber- land, ex- pulsed.	Ethelbertus, or Edelredus, Northumberland, ex- pulsed.
Alsvoldus, Northumber- land slaine,	Alsvoldus, Northumberland slaine,
Osredus.	Osredus.
Ethelbertus, or Adelwaldus, North. slaine.	Ethelbertus, or Adelwaldus, North. slaine.

After this Ethelbert, the kingdome of Northumberland ceased the space of xx. yeares, till Egbertus King of the West Saxons subdued also them, as he did the other Saxons to his dominion. After the whiche Egbert king of the West Saxons succeeded in Northumberland hys sonne. Ethelwulfus. Ethelbaldus. Kings of West Saxons, raigning in Northumberland.

Ethelbertus. Ethelredus. In the tyme of thys Ethelredus there were two vnder Kinges in Northumberland Ella, and Osbright, whom the Danes ouercame and raigned in they place, whose names were these.

After the raigne of these forslayd Danes, the kingdome of Northumberland came into the hands of the West Saxons, in the tyme of Athelstan and his brother Edmundus. It began first An. 547 and so endured 409. yeares. It contained Yorkshyre, Nottinghamshyre, Darbi-
shyre, the Bishopricke of Dyrham, Cope land and other.

Mercia.	Grida, or Creodda. 35 Wibba. 20 Ceorlus. 10 Penda, slaine. 30	Penda flew in battaile Edwyne and Oswald kings of Northumb. And Si- gebert, Edrike, and Anna, Kinges of the Eastangles. Also he drove out Ken- walk, King of the West Saxons.
	Peda, or Weda, slayne by his wife.	Under Peda, and Wlfersus, Christes fath was received in thise parts, they being converted by Finianus Bishop.
	Wlfersus. 29	The same Peda raygned in a part of Mercia, with hys brother Wlfersus, which were both the sonnes of Penda.
	Adelredus, or Ethel- red, made Monke. 30 or 31 Kenredus made also Monke at Rome., Ceolredus, or Kelre- dus.	This Wlfersus by his wife Erneburg had iii. daughters, Milburg, Mildrith, and Mildgith, holy virgines.
The Kinges of Mercia.	Ethelbaldus, slaine. 41	This Adelredus, or Ethelredus was Monke of Bardury, whose sisters were Kynedrid, and Kynswith, holy virgines.
	Bernredus.	In the tyme of this Ceolred was Guthlake otherwise called S. Guthlake, the Popish Eremitte of Crouland.
	Offa. 39	Under Ethelbaldus dyed Beda. E- thelbald gane that all churches shoule be free from all exactions and publicke charges.
	Egfredus.	This Bernred for his pride & stoutnes toward his people, was by the depo- sed, & the same yeare by the iust iudgement of God burned. Histor. Carienc.
	Kenelphus, slaine. 20 or 16	Offa raynging or solent to the dead of good Ethelbert king of the Eastan- gles, peaceably comming to mary his daughter, for repenteance caused the Peter pence first to be geue to Rome, and ther ded his penance.
	Kenelmus, murdered Ceolwulfus expul- sed. 1. or 3.	This Kenelme beyng of vi. years of age, was wickedly slayne after he had raygned vi. monethes.
	Bernolphus, slaine. 3 Lidecanus, slaine. 2	This Ludican after the 2. yeare of his raigne was slayne of Egbert, King of the West Saxons, by whome the rest of the Saxons were also subdued.

At this Wilhacu in the beginning of his raigne was vanquished
by Egfrid king of Westsaxe, to whome he became tributarie wth hys
succedours here following.

After this Elfride the kingdome of the Mercians was translated
vnto the West Saxons, in the latter tyme of king Alfred, or in the begin-
ning of Edwardus Senior, and so was adioyned to the West Saxons, be-
ginning. An. 561. It endured the space of 20. yeares, til about the latter
end of Alredus, by whome it was ioyned to the kingdome of West-
saxons. This kingdome utters out to Huntingtonshire, Mercia-
shire, Gloucestershire, Worcester, Warwick, Lichfield, Coventry, Che-
ster, Darbleshire, Stafforshire, Shropshire, Oxforde, Buckingham-
Dorchester, Lincolne, Leicester, &c.

East sax- ons.	Erichinus. 35 Sledda. 17 Sebertus, or Sigeber- tus.	This Sebertus nephew to Ethelber- tus, King of Kent amog these Kinges was first Christened by Mellitus, whiche made the Church of Danles.
	Sexredus, and Sewar- dus, brethen slaine. 7	Sixer, & Seward, and Sigebert, ex- pelled Mellitus the Bishop, because he would not minister to them the sacra- mental bread, they being not baptised.
