But before we close byp the flory of this king: there commeth to hand that which I thought not good to omit a noble purpose of the king in requiring a viewe to be ta= ken in all his dominions of all benefices and dignities ecclefiafticall remaining in the handes of Italians and Ali= ons with the true valuation of the faine directed down by commission in the time of king Richard the second wherof the like also is to be found: the tenour of which commillis on of king Edward I thought here under to fet down for worthy memory.

The king directed writtes unto all the Bjshops of England in this forme.

Edward by the grace of God king &c. To the renerend father in Christ N. But the fame grace Did and f. in Christ. N. By the same grace Bishop of L. greeting. Beyng willing vpon certayn causes to be certified what and how many benefices aswell Archdeaconries & other dignities as vicaradges personages Prebendes and Chappels within your dioces be at this present in thandes of Italians and other strangers, what they be of what valour, and how every of the fayd benefices be called by name. And how much euery of the same is worth by the yere, not as by way of Taxe or extent, but according to the true valor of the same: likewise of the names of al & singuler such strangers being now incombentes or occupying the same and enery of the; moreouer the names of all them, whether Englishmen or Straungers, of what state or condition soeuer they be whiche haue the occupacion or disposicion of any such benefices with the fruites and profites of the same in the behalfe or by the authoritie of any the foresayd Straungers by way of ferme, or title or procuration or by any other wayes or meanes whatfoeuer, and how long they haue occupyed or disposed the same : and withall if anye the sayd itraungers bee nowe refidents vppon any benefices: commaunde you as wee heretofore commaunded you that you fende vs a true certificat of all and finguler the premisses into our high Court of chauncerie under your leale distinctly and openly on this side the feast of thascention of our Lord next comming without farther delay: returning vnto vs this our writte withall. Witnesse our felfe at Westminster 16 day of April in the 48. yeare of our Reigne of England, and ouer Fraunce the 35. yeare.

 $B_{\text{pis}}^{\text{p}}$ because hereof certificat was fent up to the king into this channet out of every bioces of England of al fuch Inicitual linings as were then in the occupation eyther of Priors Aliens or of other traungers whereof the number was io great, as being all fet downe would fill almost halfe a quyer of paper. Whereby may appeare that it was highe rime for the king to leeke remedie hezein, either by treatie with the 190ye or otherwife confidering to great a postion of the renewes of his realme was by this meanes conueped awaye and employed either to the reliefe of his encmics, of magnitenaunce of the forreners: Amongli whiche number, the Cardinals of the courte of Bome lacked not their hare. As may appeare by this which followeth.

The Lord fraunces of the citle of S. Sabyne, 19 well and Cardinall of the holy Church of Rome doth hold and cuiop the Deanry of the Cathedrall Church of Lichfield whiche is worth in the inrilaiction of Lichfield fine hundreth marks by the yeare. And y Hiebend of Brewood, ethe personage of Abbaston to the same Deanry annexed, which piebend is worth by the years source store marks and thepersonage twenty pound, which deancy with the prebendes & peria nage aforefayo hee hath holden and occupyed by the space of z, peres. And one maifter de in grisa ftrager as proctor to the faide Cardinall doth hold and occupy the fame Deancy with other y premises with thappurtenances by name of 1910ctor during the yeares aforefayd, and hath taken op the frances and profices, to the fayd Cardinall, dwelling not in the Bealme.

L. William Cardinall of S. Angelo, a ftraunger both holde the Archdeaconvyc of Suff. by vertue of proution Apollodicall from the feast of S. Picholas last past, be is not resident uppon his fayd Archdeacoury. And the layd Archd, together with the procuration due by reason of the vilitation is worth by yeare Levilli. rin. s.iii.d. And mai= ther John of Belinington. &c. doth occupy the scale of thos= ficiall of the laid Archdeacoury, &c.

A. Lemnald of Sadziane Deacon Cardinall: hath in the fair County the perionadge of Bodalmonge, worth by pearextipound, and one Edward Teweste doth ferme the fayd perfonadge for ir peares paft.

The L. Anglicus of the holy Church of Rome priese and Cardinall, a fraunger was incumbent a bid holde in possession the Deanry of the Cathedial Churche of Yorke from the 11. day of Poucmber Anno. Dom. 1366. and is yearely worth according to the true valor thereof inf. C.li. and mailter John of Stoke Canon of the layd Churche,

both occupy the faid Deanry and the profites of the fame in the name of by the authoritie of the layd L. Deane sc. But the laid Deane was never relident oppon the fayd Deanry lince he was admitted thereunto.

Item. L. Bewgh of our Lady in Deacon and Lardmalla ftraunger both posselle the Prebeno of Duffila in the layd Church of Yorke from the 7. day of Junic Ann. Do. 1363. from whiche day. &c.
